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1 PURPOSE

This policy outlines the overarching principles for climate and environment at Avinor. The purpose is to improve Avinor's own environmental performance and ensure the company is an active driver of sustainable aviation.

2 SCOPE

The policy applies to the entire Avinor Group.

3 RESPONSIBILITY AND AUTHORITY

Avinor's management is responsible for establishing and revising the policy.

The Sustainability Department is responsible for communicating and making the corporate policy available as part of the overall environmental management in the group.

The line organisation holds operational responsibility for meeting environmental requirements in central or local action plans within the organisation.

4 STRATEGY / POLICY

Avinor shall comply with both regulatory and internal requirements, and its environmental management shall be certified according to ISO 14001, ensuring systematic coordination and follow-up of environmental efforts.

Avinor shall have a complete overview of its total climate and environmental impact and actively work to reduce it by:

- Emphasising Avinor's climate and sustainability goals in decision-making
- Being an active driver of sustainable aviation. It shall be easy for travellers to make sustainable choices at our airports
- Setting science-based short- and long-term climate goals, and annually reducing emissions from own operations
- Collaborating with the rest of the aviation industry and facilitating that Norwegian aviation achieves the goal of being fossil-free by 2050
- Ensuring that activities at Avinor's airports do not cause new soil contamination or deteriorate water environment quality
- Operating and developing airports in a way that minimises harm to nature. Nature of national and significant regional interest shall be especially prioritised, and positive measures implemented where possible
- Working according to circular economy principles with optimal use of material resources
- Actively working to limit noise pollution from aircraft and helicopter traffic for residents in the vicinity of airports

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- Seeking to trade and collaborate with suppliers and partners who take the environment seriously. Where possible, Avinor shall prioritise choosing environmentally certified products and services and collaborate with environmentally certified suppliers and partners
- Ensuring that climate and environment are central in decisions regarding planning, establishment, development, and operation of Avinor's buildings and infrastructure

5 MANAGEMENT AND COMPLIANCE

The policy is maintained as documented information through annual evaluation in management reviews and shall be assessed for its effectiveness in contributing to

Avinor's short- and long-term climate and environmental strategy.

Concrete actions to ensure compliance and goal achievement are established within the organisation and followed up through central and local action plans for environment and climate.

The policy is communicated to all employees at Avinor and will be available to stakeholders as needed.
